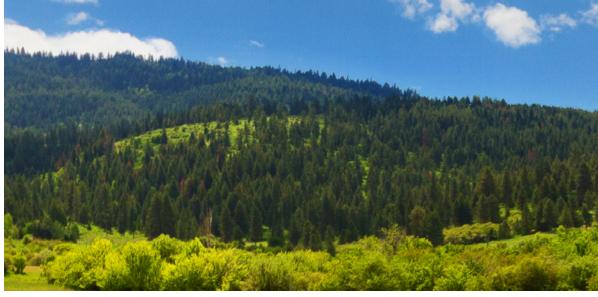

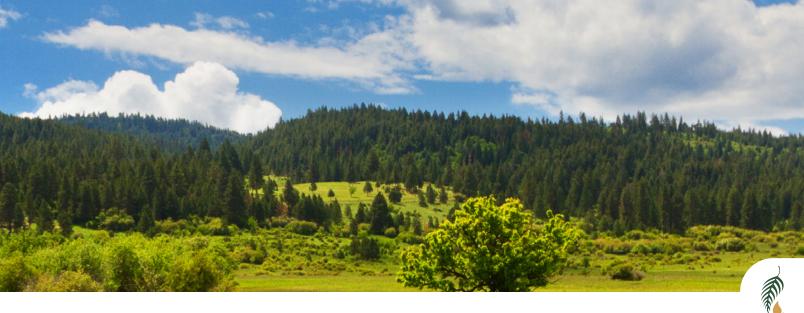

Economics is the study of maximizing outcomes under constraints. Your greatest constraint isn't money—it's time.

Recently, I had the opportunity to sit down with Dr. Corinne Low, an economist at the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania. I immensely enjoyed our conversation. Even though the subject was economics, the conversation didn't feel theoretical. It felt practical.

Dr. Low told me that economics, at its core, is about maximizing outcomes under constraints. For companies, that means maximizing profit under the constraints of costs, capacity, and demand.

But for you and me, it means maximizing utility—our deeper, lived sense of meaning and well-being-under the constraints of time and effort.

Use Every Hour on Purpose

One especially profound observation stood out to me from my conversation with Dr. Low. It was this: Your scarcest resource is not money. It's time.

It's 8:00 a.m. The smell of protein pancakes fills the air as twin boys bounce happily around their mother's feet, each clutching a Koala Pals™ Shakeables® nutrition shake. An 18-month-old toddler reaches for the spatula. Amid the happy chaos, Natasha takes a coaching call on her wireless headset—part of the daily rhythm that's transformed her life. When Tori Farr was approached about trying Melaleuca products, she figured she had nothing to lose. "I had never heard of Melaleuca before, and my friend Jamie Martin told me about the products and the ability to earn money from home," she explains. "I had been a dental assistant for 10 years, and now, as a stay-at-home mom, I was kind of missing having my own income. So I decided I might as well give it a shot."

As Tori ventured into running her Melaleuca business, she had to overcome some common concerns. "It was definitely scary," she says. "I was very in my head at the start. What would people think of me?' I didn't want to come across as someone who was just trying to sell them something for my own personal gain, so I really tried to come from a place of, 'Why would this benefit their family, and why would it be a good fit for them?"

That initial fear became a natural talking point that helped her relate to potential customers and builders. "Now when I share about how I was nervous at first about people judging me and that no one would support me, I also share that they need to know that their team members are out there," Tori explains. Not everyone has a strong support circle. "They may not be your family and close friends—they might be internet strangers—but there are people out there who will support you. You just have to be your authentic self, and they'll be attracted to that."

Another thing that a lot of her customers and business builders can relate to is having household supplies that are safe and healthy. "I tend to approach busy moms with families," she says. "I love the cleaning supplies and that there's no child caps on the lids so my kids can help me clean and I don't have to worry about them getting into harsh chemicals."

A few years before discovering Melaleuca, Tori lost her mother to cancer, and the nontoxic products offered here were definitely a big draw. "After I lost my mom, I liked the idea of having safer, healthier products in my home—I wish I would have been using them my whole life," she says. "I just think the company, the products—everything—are so incredible that I truly try and educate people and share what we have our hands on, and then let them decide if it's a good fit for them. The fact that I could also earn some money and help others was just icing on the cake."

Tori's goal is to help other people, educate them on products, and make a difference for both her family and theirs. "Seeing the impact that we're making really inspires me," she says. "For a while, I'd lost my spark in motherhood, but Melaleuca helped me find it again—and now I get to help other moms who are in that same position. Many of them are looking for something meaningful outside the home, another way to contribute to their families. I just know my mom would be so proud of the work I'm doing to support these families." 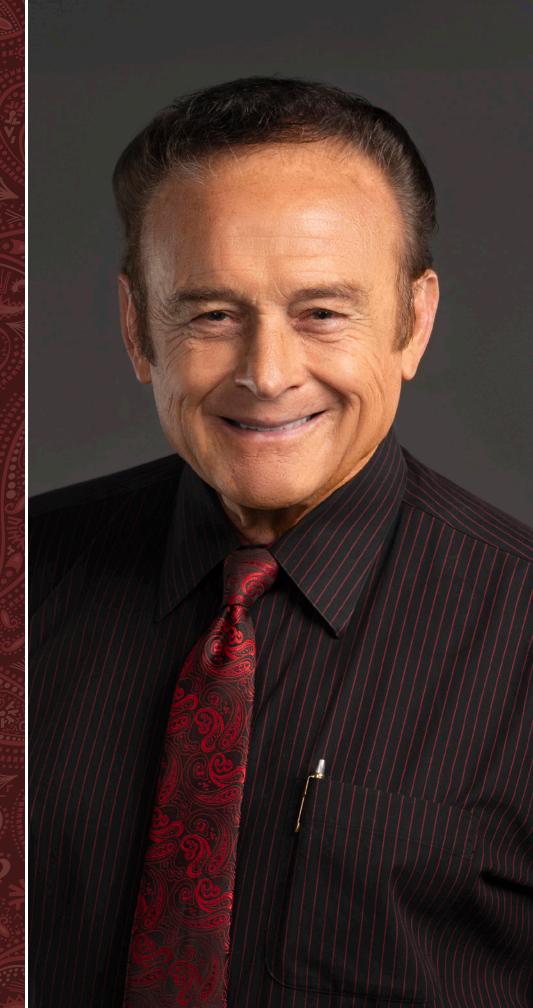

RETIRES

Think about the moments that made your business easier the training that clicked, the product information that went below the surface, the policy answer that empowered you. That's Lewis Rasmussen's fingerprint on Melaleuca. After 38 years of pairing his warm humor with his sharp business acumen, Lewis has retired, leaving behind a legacy of leadership, culture, and impact.



WHERE THE WORK ETHIC STARTED

Lewis grew up in the wide-open spaces of Southeast Idaho, in the tiny farm town of Grace—population 920. His boyhood was stitched together with days spent hiking ridgelines, hunting in the fields, fishing the rivers, and roaring down dirt roads on a motorcycle. From age 12 on, he earned money doing manual labor on local farms. As a teenager, he met his future wife, Laurie, when he worked as a farmhand on her father's potato farm. His upbringing set the tone for his life. He learned to work hard, play hard, honor community, and value integrity.

In such a small town, career options were limited. For two decades, Lewis worked on his father-in-law's farm. tried electrician work, bought a carpetcleaning business, and managed a hardware store. When Lewis was first approached about an MLM, it sounded like a great way to help his family get ahead. But it didn't pan out the way he thought it would. So he tried again. And again. And again. Altogether, Lewis tried his hand at 23 different MLMs. There was a common denominator to all of them. "They'd always come through town and show you big dreams and all the big money you could make," Lewis recalls. "But it was the typical MLM story—here today and gone tomorrow."

UNLIKE ANYTHING ELSE

In 1988, Laurie's sister showed the Rasmussens a presentation about Melaleuca, and Lewis immediately saw the difference between Melaleuca and MLM companies. He and Laurie enrolled and began sharing Melaleuca with others.

His favorite enrollment is personal: his mother. She was 80, a retired nurse living on Social Security, and she was apprehensive after watching her son's earlier MLM attempts. At his insistence, she became one of his first enrollments. In time, her Melaleuca income eventually added \$2,000-\$3,000 a month to her retirement income. She had lived her whole life washing laundry by hand and hanging clean clothes to dry outdoors—even in the frigid Idaho winters. Thanks to her Melaleuca income, she could finally have her home rewired, buy her first washing machine and dryer, and enjoy the independence she'd never thought was possible. "It made such a difference for her," Lewis says. "She was able to do so much with that money."



A LEADER OF LEADERS

Early on, Lewis became passionate about training others. "Melaleuca offered a training program called the Fast Forward Workshop, which helped Marketing Executives master the art of teaching others about the products and the Compensation Plan. I took the course and got qualified as a Fast Forward Trainer. I enjoyed being in front of people and explaining things to them." His natural ability to connect with others and read an audience allowed Lewis to become a sought-after educator. "Before long, other Marketing











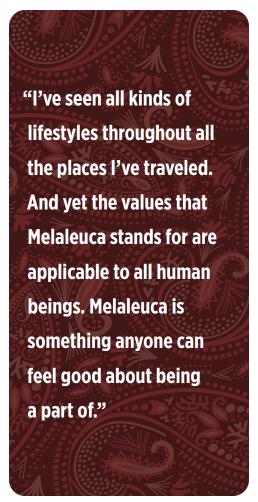






Executives began asking me to come and train their teams."

Lewis's gifts did not go unnoticed. After four years, Melaleuca Executive Chairman Frank VanderSloot invited Lewis to move to Idaho Falls and do what he did best as a corporate employee. "Frank was very persuasive,



so in 1992, I gave up my Melaleuca business to work at the corporate headquarters, and I became Melaleuca's first Regional Manager."

BUILDING FROM WITHIN

For 25 years, Lewis was a teacher of teachers. He trained thousands of workshop attendees on Melaleuca's exceptional products, unique business model, and valued culture in every US state, every Canadian province, and 14 countries—logging more than six million airline miles. With each mile, he carried Melaleuca's mission farther.

In nearly four decades, Lewis witnessed extraordinary change. "When I started in 1988, Melaleuca did just barely over \$1 million in sales," he says. "Now it does more than \$2 billion a year." Lewis played a pivotal role in many decisions that have shaped the company you know and love today. From Leadership Points and Compensation Plan enhancements to product information, Lewis has been an advocate for every Marketing Executive and customer.

He counts his relationships with leaders among his greatest rewards. "In the early days, I knew every single advancing leader," Lewis says. "I would stay at their homes when I visited their towns. And he's known for the vibrant flower garden that flourishes every summer under his green thumb.

Retirement for Lewis won't mean slowing down. "I'll be spending a lot of time outside in my flower garden," he says. "And with 25 grandkids, trust me, there's never a dull moment." He also joked that his wife, Laurie, has a honeydo list that's been growing for years. "It's longer than you can imagine!"



And there will be time for simple joys. "I love to go to movies," Lewis says. "In fact, I was recognized a couple years ago as number three in the nation for Regal Cinemas moviegoers," he laughs.

Not everyone says yes—and that's fine. I keep them on my contact list and follow up when new products or offers come out. What I never do is pressure.

My passion for Melaleuca shines through in every interaction, and I make sure my customers feel valued long after they enroll.

Each month, I check in with a quick text:

"Have you placed your order yet? Want to see what I tried this month?"

A customer I worked hard to enroll deserves my continued care.

Some of my best advice is to get creative with how you share Melaleuca. For me, that means making short videos for social media. I'll show Sei Bella® products in my makeup bag or the EcoSense® products in my kitchen, shower, and laundry room. My daughter, Macee, even makes her own videos for her Instagram followers. Her generation loves video. Truthfully, everyone responds well to authenticity. These quick clips aren't just fun; they're effective. They give people ideas for products they haven't tried yet **National Director** Jessie Trudeau



and for new ways to share Melaleuca with their friends and family. It's so simple and real!

I'll admit, videos were outside my comfort zone at first.

But if you want your business to grow, you have to be willing to try something different.

And sharing Melaleuca really is easy when you know you're offering something valuable—healthier options for families, savings on essentials, and even extra income.

I love sharing my favorite things, so naturally, I started by calling my mom, my sister, and my best friend. Melaleuca products are simply too good not to share. The key is to connect authentically. For me, that means talking about the products I rely on most. I like to think of myself as a poster child for Mela-Out Magnesium. It helps my sleep, my mood, and my muscles. So I share that story.

Once you make an approach and walk someone through the Melaleuca Overview, don't stop there. Nurture those relationships. Building with Melaleuca is about leading with heart.

This past year has been life-changing for my family, and I want others to experience the same freedom-freedom of time, money, and health.

My other piece of advice is that if someone isn't ready, you should never take it personally. I think of the "piece of gum" theory: If you offer gum to a group, maybe Joe doesn't want one today. That's fine. You know that the gum is good. And maybe next time, Joe will say yes.

The key is to keep believing—in the products, in the business model, and in the people. I remind prospects that Melaleuca is not an autoship company. It's a Consumer Direct™ shopping club that delivers fresher products at better prices. As a customer, I view my Membership as a partnership: I commit to monthly shopping, and in return I get higher quality items at a 30% discount. That's a win-win.







To me, Melaleuca just makes sense. We're talking about toothpaste, soap, laundry detergent—the things you already buy. Only here, the company thanks you with a commission. Why wouldn't you shop with a company that respects your dollars?

The truth is that right now, so many people need extra income. They're driving for Uber, delivering for DoorDash, or picking up other side hustles. There's no shame in that. But Melaleuca is the best side gig on the planet!

Think about it: You don't have to create products, ship them, or store them. Yet the company pays you commissions and bonuses every month for as long as you are an active Marketing Executive. That's monthly repeat income for helping others. That's real entrepreneurship made simple.

I tell people,

"This is the smartest side gig out there. You just play your part, share the store, and get rewarded." That's worth getting excited about.

I'm a middle-aged mom to three boys, and I don't pretend to be anyone else online.

The key to sharing Melaleuca is to be unapologetically yourself.

For me, that means posting about the real stuff—the good, the bad, and the ugly.

I've shared openly about losing my mom, facing a cancer scare, and struggling with social anxiety during COVID. Being vulnerable has not only fueled my business, but it's also allowed me to mentor others who are going through hard times.

- 3. What are you obsessed with?

- 5. What are you best known for?

These "five things" define your personal brand. Mine include being a football mom to three boys, loving tacos and bubble baths, and supporting anti-bullying causes. By getting specific, I connect with people who resonate with me.

People love raw and real. You don't need to be a 25-year-old influencer.

Share your life as it is, and you'll attract others who connect with your story.

That's the heart of Melaleuca—building relationships that make the world a little kinder.





When I make approaches, my language is rooted in transparency.

I address the two questions most people have right away: Is Melaleuca an MLM? and How do I shop for 35 Product Points every month?

First, I clear the air: Melaleuca may look similar to network marketing, but it's very different. You'll never carry inventory or go into debt. It's simply a shopping club like Amazon, only better because you're buying directly from the manufacturer and can earn money if you choose to share it.

My focus is always on finding true business partners—people ready for change and willing to put in the work. Transparency attracts the right leaders.

Ultimately, the numbers speak for themselves: Melaleuca has a 96% monthly retention rate. Customers stick around because they find products they love and can't live without!

The #1 approach that I teach my new Marketing Executives starts with excitement because excitement is contagious. I'll say:

"I've been shopping at an online store that saves us time and money on the things we use every day. We love it and I'd love to share it with you. Plus, every time I refer someone, the company sends me a thank-you check."

That simple language opens the door. From there, I teach the FORM method—Family, Occupation, Recreation, Money—to guide conversations. I always ask about someone's family or job and listen for problems Melaleuca can help solve.

Then, when the moment's right, I'll say:

"This might be a shot in the dark, but do you keep your options open?"

Most people don't want to seem closedminded, so they'll say ves. That's when I share more about Melaleuca's business opportunity.

One of my new Directors, Mark, is a sheriff's deputy with 28 years on the job. His goal is to retire early. His approach is simple: "I've found something I'm doing from home to supplement my income so I can retire next year." Who wouldn't want to hear more?

At the end of the day, it's about keeping it simple, staying excited, and sharing authentically.

When Brittney McLaughlin talks about onboarding new Marketing Executives, her system is simple, duplicable, and effective. She knows that the first few days matter most. "Leaders go first," Brittney says. "Your team will follow what you do. If you start every new enrollee with Grow, you will build momentum that lasts."

There's no question that Grow helps streamline the path to success. Data indicates that new Category 2 or 3 Marketing Executives who use Grow in their first 90 days are 3.2 times more likely to enroll a customer and are 5.5 times more likely to advance to Director. And new Directors who used Grow in their first 90 days enrolled their first customer 34% faster than those who didn't use Grow, and they enrolled 25% more customers in their first 90 days.

Putting the steps for success right at a new enrollee's fingertips removes confusion and builds confidence from day one. Brittney has seen it firsthand

on her team: "We are watching new builders come in, take action quickly, and see results faster than ever before."

REMOVING ROADBLOCKS

In the past, new builders sometimes stalled because they weren't sure what to do first or couldn't easily find the right training. Grow eliminates that friction. As soon as a new enrollee completes a step, their enroller receives a notification—making follow-up timely and natural.

Brittney follows the same five steps with every new Category 2 or 3 enrollee:

- 1. Enroll and shop. Help them set up their Melaleuca account and place their first order.
- 2. Subscribe and download Grow. Guide them to Melaleuca.com/ Grow to subscribe and activate their free trial before downloading the app.
- 3. Watch the Foundations video. This builds belief, teaches basic principles, and positions them to earn Pacesetter Bonuses.
- 4. Create their first contact list. Encourage them to import at least 20 names from their phone into Grow to bring to their first Strategy Session.
- **5. Schedule and complete a Strategy Session.** Partner with them to make a game plan for reaching out and advancing.

"Don't overcomplicate it," Brittney emphasizes. "This is the same process we've always followed, but Grow makes it streamlined and professional. Everything your new enrollee needs is right in the palm of their hand."

BUILDING CONFIDENCE WITH CONTACT LISTS

One of the most powerful features in Grow is the contact list builder. For years, new enrollees were told to write out their first 50 names on paper. But with Grow, they can import names directly from their phone in minutes.

LEADERSHIP AT EVERY AGE

Some Marketing Executives worry that new technology may be a barrier for older enrollees. Brittney has found the opposite. "I recently worked with a woman in her late sixties," Brittney says. "She had already downloaded Grow, watched the Foundations video, and created her contact list-without needing any extra help. She told me it was simple."

Don't assume someone can't do it. Most people today use smartphones daily. "Grow builds confidence," Brittney says. "Whether you're brand new or you've been around for years, the Grow app makes the business easier and more organized."

THE POWER OF DUPLICATION

The key, Brittney insists, is consistency. "Your team will do what you do. If you're using Grow, celebrating their steps inside Grow, and leading by example, they'll adopt it too. But if you're still relying on pen and paper, they'll see that and follow suit."

She encourages leaders to embrace the change: "This is no different than when our customers say, 'I'm just going to keep shopping at Walmart because I know where everything is.' Leaders don't just create shoppers they create leaders. Stay focused on Directors 3, and your organization will multiply with strength.

When it comes to building a stable Melaleuca business, one principle rises above the rest: Growth happens when you help others grow. The turning point in my own business came when I shifted from focusing only on my goals to focusing on helping others succeed.

Here's the truth: We don't just find Directors 3—we develop them. And that takes grit, consistency, and belief. But the reward is worth it. Those who work the hardest for their success are those who stick around the longest and become the strongest leaders.

Cast a Vision That Inspires

At the heart of developing Directors 3 is the why—the personal reason that drives someone on the hard days. Without a why, the work can feel mechanical. Day after day, we're building contact

lists, making approaches, setting appointments, and working through the Seven Critical Business-Building Activities. On top of that, we often face rejection from friends or family who don't yet understand what we're building. That's why connecting each new Director to their *why* is so important.

For me, my why is my family. My husband and two little girls love Melaleuca, and they are the reason I build my business every single day. My vision is to give them the very best life—physically, mentally, and financially. That vision keeps me going, and I encourage every new builder to connect to their own.

From there, it's about painting a picture of what's possible. Share the opportunities that open up at each

step: the Critical Activity Bonus, the 20/20 Club, the Pacesetter Program, and, ultimately, the incredible possibilities that come with reaching Director 3.

Breathe Belief into New Directors

If you don't believe, your team won't believe. Leaders lend their conviction until their team builds their own.

When I first started my Melaleuca business, I didn't have much belief in myself. I borrowed it from my enroller, Executive Director 9 Jessi Harris, who introduced me to Melaleuca. Jessi made me feel like I could accomplish anything if I was willing to work hard enough.

Belief—combined with consistent action—creates momentum. Every call, follow-up, coaching session, and word of encouragement spreads confidence and energy throughout the team.

Coach with Clear Steps

Inspiration matters, but growth doesn't happen by chance—it happens through systems and intentional mentoring.

One of my favorite tools for developing Directors is the Grow app. If you're not using it, start now! It tracks progress, maps goals, and helps builders know exactly what to do next. But tools alone don't build Directors 3—relationships do.

That's why I schedule Strategy Sessions whether over video call or in person—to walk new builders step-by-step through the Director advancement path. When people see the map, everything changes. They stop guessing, and they start moving with confidence.

Remember that duplication is key. If I'm the only one doing presentations or Strategy Sessions, my team won't grow. But when I empower others to do the same, the whole organization gets stronger.

Plant the Seeds That Grow Great Leaders

Sometimes developing Directors 3 feels like planting seeds and waiting for them to sprout. Not every effort brings immediate results, but consistency pays off.

My job isn't to force growth. It's to create the right environment. Some seeds grow quickly, while others take time. But when they do grow, they grow strong.

This mindset turns setbacks into opportunities. A no isn't failure it's "not yet." A slow month isn't defeat—it's a chance to refocus. Every call, every follow-up, every conversation is part of a bigger story of leadership and growth.

Why is Director 3 so pivotal? Because it's the foundation of leadership. Builders who reach Director 3 prove they can duplicate, support others, and create consistent growth. When someone hits Director 3, everything shifts. They believe in themselves. They see that this business really works. And once they've done it, they can teach it. That's when you start creating leaders who create leaders.

This ripple effect is how small teams become thriving communities—each person empowered to build a better future through Melaleuca.

Heed the Call to Step Up

At its core, developing Directors 3 isn't just about rank advancement. It's about transforming lives. Leaders

believe in someone until that person believes in themselves. They cast the vision until others can see it too. They guide until their partners are ready to lead.

For me, that's the greatest reward. The checks are nice, and the ranks are exciting—but nothing compares to seeing someone else win. That's why I'll never stop helping people reach Director 3. Because when leaders rise, everyone rises.

Path to Director 3: **A Quick Checklist**

- 1. Discover the Why. Help new builders clarify what motivates them.
- 2. Set the Goal. Map the path to Director 1, 2, and 3 with clear milestones.
- 3. Start Strong. Encourage new builders to enroll their first 8-10 shoppers.
- 4. Use the Tools. Leverage the Grow app, 20/20 Club, and Pacesetter Program.
- 5. Stay in Action. Schedule Strategy Sessions and follow-ups right away.
- 6. **Teach Duplication.** Host Melaleuca Overview presentations and Strategy Sessions, then empower new builders to lead their own.
- 7. Build Belief. Lend confidence until new builders develop their own.
- 8. Celebrate Wins. Recognize every advancement-big or small-to fuel momentum.

Dopamine is a mood enhancer. It amplifies the pleasure you feel when something goes right for you, producing a greater sense of positivity and well-being.

It turns out that the more gratitude you feel, the more dopamine is released. Your brain likes dopamine so much that it has all the incentive to repeat the mental process of finding ways to be grateful.

MAKE IT A HABIT

When you repeat an action so often that you don't even think about it anymore, you've developed a habit, and there's a reason why you're replicating that action.

Habits follow a pattern called a habit loop, which consists of a cue, a routine, and a reward. Many habits are developed unconsciously as your brain seeks rewards. You might not even realize that a particular behavior of yours has become a habit. However, you can consciously form habits too. The process isn't easy. To form a beneficial habit, you may have to break some bad habits first. Then you'll need to connect positive behavior to cues that triggered your negative behavior before. That takes consistent, conscious effort at first. But as your brain rewires itself to prioritize this positive response, it gradually becomes second nature to you.

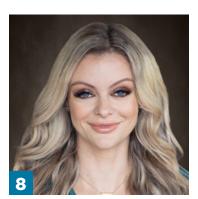

Katrice Walker GEORGIA

After Years of Searching, She Found Renew®

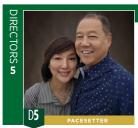

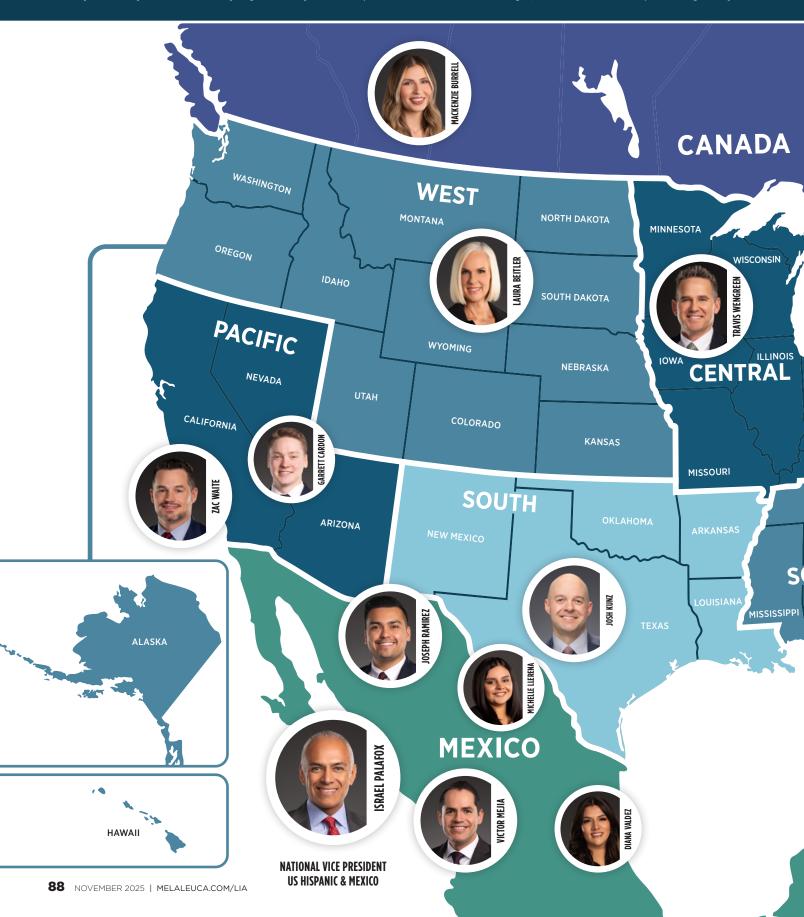

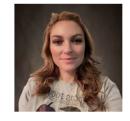
