No one better embodies this concept more and is a better example than the man who wrote our mission and lives it every day, our Founder and Executive Chairman, Frank VanderSloot.

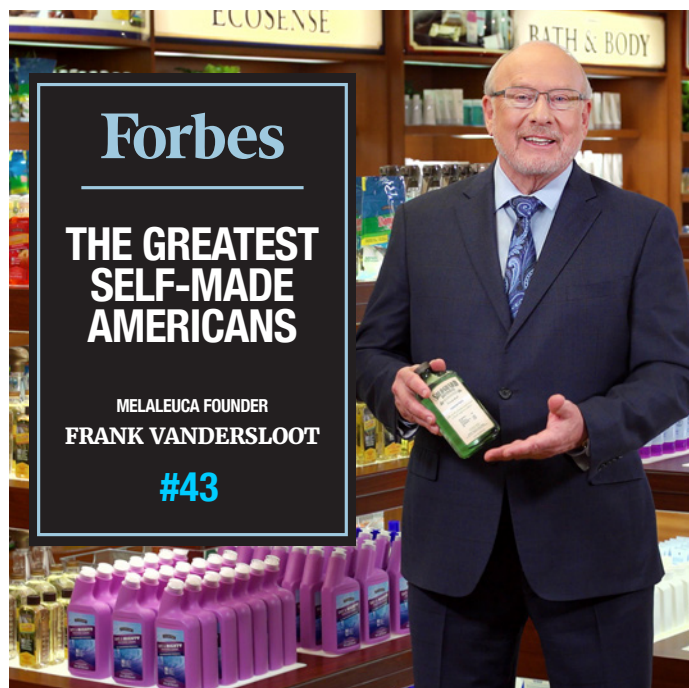

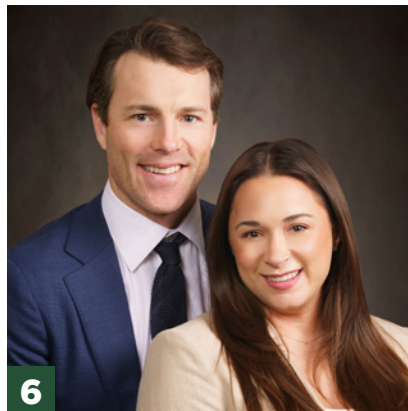

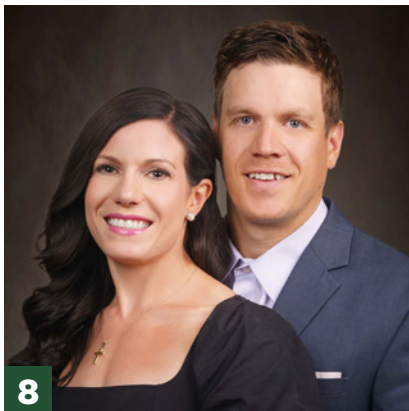

## Graduation Season for Grown-Ups: Get Out of The Waiting Place!

Graduation season is full of caps, gowns, pictures, parties—and that iconic Dr. Seuss book, *Oh, the Places You'll Go!* This book has sold over 10 million copies since it was published in 1991.

To get you in the Dr. Seuss mindset, here are the first few lines of *Oh, the Places You'll Go!*

**Congratulations!  
Today is your day.  
You're off to Great Places!  
You're off and away!**

**You have brains in your head.  
You have feet in your shoes.  
You can steer yourself  
any direction you choose.**

**You're on your own. And you know  
what you know. And YOU are the  
guy who'll decide where to go.**

### **What's Not to Love About That?**

Most people gift this book to a high school or college graduate and think, “Cute. Inspiring. Memorable.” But the older you get, the more you realize that this is so much more than a children’s story. It’s a leadership lesson hiding in plain sight.

There’s one particular section of *Oh, the Places You'll Go!* that reads less like a rhyme

and more like a warning. That section talks about somewhere called The Waiting Place. And if you’re honest, you don’t have to be a new graduate to recognize what The Waiting Place is. You just have to be someone who has found yourself delaying what matters most.

### **The Adult Graduations Nobody Celebrates**

When you graduate from high school or college, you end that chapter of your life in public. People celebrate you. They clap. They take pictures. There’s a ceremony, a party, and cake.

Adult graduations are different. These graduations can be as or even more momentous than a school graduation, but they happen often, and almost always in silence. No cap, no gown, no applause. Life simply hands you a new chapter and asks, “Who are you going to be now?”

Sometimes that new chapter is positive, like a promotion at work or—as a Melaleuca Marketing Executive—an advancement that you’ve worked hard to achieve. But sometimes it’s negative, like a layoff you didn’t see coming, a divorce, a child moving away, a health wake-up call, or a challenging season with your business. Sometimes everything looks fine

on the outside, but inside you feel like you're still a long way from becoming who you want to be.

These kinds of moments come with a quiet decision point. Will you step up into this new chapter, or will you stall? Will you grow, or will you wait?

**For Parents, This Isn't Just Personal—It's Modeling**

One of the most meaningful graduation gifts you can give a graduate isn't one more speech—instead, let them watch

you step into your own next chapter with courage and humility.

I recently saw a statistic that puts urgency on that idea. By the time your child turns 18, you've already spent about 95% of the time you'll ever spend with them. In fact, about 75% of that time is already gone by age 12.

If you're waiting for life to slow down, it won't. This chapter is being written whether you like it or not. And what your

kids see in you—such as how seriously you take your health, how much effort you put into your marriage, how honest you try to be, and how consistently you start again when life puts a speed bump in your way—teaches them what no book ever will. Your life is a lesson, and it's still being written.

**The Waiting Place—Where Momentum Disappears**

In *Oh, the Places You'll Go!*, Dr. Seuss is encouraging but not naive. Yes, you're capable. Yes, you can go places. But sometimes you find yourself heading toward The Waiting Place instead.

**And when you're in a Slump, you're not in for much fun. Un-slumping yourself is not easily done....**

**You can get so confused that you'll start in to race down long wiggled roads at a break-necking pace... headed, I fear, toward a most useless place.**

## The Waiting Place...for people just waiting.

For someone who is building their Melaleuca business, The Waiting Place is where momentum disappears. You know you've found The Waiting Place if you've recently said, "I'll start when...."

It's important to note that The Waiting Place isn't where lazy people go. It's not just where discouraged people end up. It's where capable and hardworking people land, maybe after being told *no* one too many times. It's where responsible people go when they're tired of risking being wrong. It's where you may go when you hit a flat spot in your Melaleuca business. It's where you pause in doing something that truly matters—quietly.

### Being Busy but Stuck

For parents, leaders, and Melaleuca Marketing Executives alike, waiting rarely looks like doing nothing. Waiting often looks like being busy, even productive, and most likely exhausted—all while still feeling stuck.

It sounds like "I'll focus on my health when this quarter ends." Or "I'll be more present when the kids get older." Or "I'll start making approaches when I feel confident." Or "I'll follow up with my friend when the timing is right." Or "I'll

reset my priorities when this season is over."

If that's you, you're not broken. You're human. But it's worth recognizing that The Waiting Place rarely steals your future in one dramatic decision. It steals it in tiny delays.

And here's what hits leaders especially hard: Waiting often feels responsible. It can even sound wise. But most of the time it's just fear with a calendar. Fear of failing. Fear of hearing a *no*. Fear of wasting effort. Fear of bothering someone. Fear of discovering you waited too long to follow up. And sometimes it isn't fear at all! Sometimes it's just you staying safe in your comfort zone.

Either way, Dr. Seuss was right. The Waiting Place is a bad place to live! And it's not because you won't be productive there, but because you won't be moving ahead in work that really matters and becoming someone better.

### A Quick Self-Audit

Don't overthink it. Where are you waiting right now? Where are you in a holding pattern—in your health, marriage, family, or Melaleuca business? Get out a notebook and write it down. Be honest.

### Why High Performers Get Trapped Waiting

High-performing people are especially vulnerable to getting stuck in The Waiting Place because they can always find something important to work on. Does this sound like you? As a Marketing Executive, there is always one more line of your go-to approach to perfect before picking up the phone. There's always a "more responsible time" to make an approach or schedule a strategy session—which usually means *not now*. As a result, you may delay doing the activities that grow your business and build momentum in your team.

Over time, the habit of delay may even start to feel like maturity! However, delay is often simply avoidance dressed in responsibility.

If this message feels sharp, know that it isn't meant to shame you. It's meant to support you into thinking about this problem clearly. You don't need drama. You need direction.

### WAIT: A Simple Exit Plan You Can Run This Week

Here's a framework for leaving The Waiting Place without blowing up your life. I call it WAIT.

**W** What am I waiting for? Ask yourself what moment you're waiting for that may never come and what feeling you're waiting for, such as confidence, clarity, or energy. Most people aren't waiting for time. They're waiting for a feeling. And feelings are unreliable leaders.

**A** Add one standard. Not ten goals. One standard. A standard is a nonnegotiable rule that you live by during this season, something clear enough to put on a calendar. Examples include adding five names every day to your contact list, giving your kids ten phone-free minutes when you walk in the door, doing a short check-in with your spouse a few nights a week, and scheduling a Strategy Session that happens within 48 hours of enrollment for each new customer you enroll.

**I** Insert it on the calendar (today). If it isn't scheduled, it's a wish. And if it's a wish, The Waiting Place can easily keep you from getting it done.

**T** Tell one person. Call or text one person you know you can depend on and say, "Hold me to this." Accountability turns intention into movement.



### Just Start

As a Marketing Executive, it's important for you to have clear, compelling long-term goals. But it's easy to get dazzled by those goals. Could that really be you being recognized for that big advancement? Could that be you earning that repeat income? That would involve so many changes that you might not know where to start. It's the same feeling you might get if you had a beautiful painting in your mind's eye but were staring at a blank canvas. You're paralyzed because you think your work will have to be perfect from the very first brushstroke.

My challenge to you when you find yourself at this point is to just start! Block out the next hour. Then put your head down and go to work doing the Seven Critical Business-Building Activities. Don't second-guess yourself. Don't stop to analyze. Don't worry about doing everything perfectly. Just stay in motion.

Why can this get you moving when not even your best intentions can? Because perfection won't get you to your goal. Momentum will.

You don't have to know how the entire process is going to go in order to get moving. You just have to start.

### The 7-Day “Get Out of The Waiting Place” Challenge

For the next seven days, do the following exercise. You're not doing it to prove something or impress someone. Doing this will help you build momentum. Momentum changes your mind.

Pick one chapter of your life that you've relegated to The Waiting Place. Put it

on the calendar today. Tell one person for accountability. If the chapter is parenting, schedule one intentional hour this week with your child—phone away, fully present—and have the gentle conversation you've been avoiding. If the chapter is leadership, have the clarity conversation you've delayed with your team member. Remember, feedback, expectations, boundaries, and truth are not unkind when delivered with respect.

If the chapter is achieving your next business goal, complete one measurable action, like adding five names to your contact list or making three approaches, so you can say, “That's done.” If the chapter is improving your health, choose

one standard for seven days—three workouts, getting to bed on time, or eating a healthy meal every evening.

You don't need to create a whole new life this week. You just need one small win that proves you're moving.

### Begin Without a Ceremony

Graduation season is a reminder that chapters turn. And if you're in an adult graduation right now—quiet and unseen—hear this: You don't need a ceremony to begin again. You don't need permission. You don't need perfect timing. You don't need the feeling first.

You need one decision that says, “I'm stepping out of The Waiting Place.”

Pick your chapter. Schedule it today. Tell one person. Then stop waiting and take the next small step forward. **LIA**

It's a calm late-spring afternoon, and they are watching their son and daughter, ages four and two, explore their new domain. Morgan is smiling, reflecting on a conversation she had recently had with her son.

"I was preparing to fly to Texas to host an Executive Director Perspective event," Morgan says. "I told my son that I had to leave. He asked me why. I told him that it was for work. And he said, very seriously, 'You don't work!'"

"First, I laughed. Then, as those words sunk in, I thought, 'Oh my gosh, I did it!'"

She wasn't thinking of her recent advancement to Corporate Director 4. She was thinking of the example she had set for a four-year-old boy. She had worked hard. 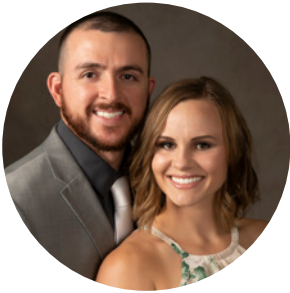

# IF NOT NOW, WHEN?

In a recent episode of Leadercast, Darrin Johnson sat down with National Directors Shelby and AJ Ford to discuss how their Melaleuca business has helped them build a life of consistency, peace of mind, and presence. It's a message that every growing Marketing Executive needs to hear.

## Balancing the Busyness

If there is one word that describes the Fords' current season of life, it is *full*.

They are raising three children, navigating sports schedules, and keeping pace with the demands of family life. But underneath the busyness is something deeply intentional.

"There's a lot of balancing going on," Shelby says. "It definitely takes the A-team. We prioritize our family and those important moments, the tournaments, the things that we want to be at—that goes first in our calendar. And then we calendar our work, our Melaleuca activity."

That order says everything. The Fords are not trying to squeeze family life in around everything else. They are building their business in a way that protects family first. And that has changed what their life feels like.

When asked what Melaleuca's repeat income has meant to him as a husband and father, AJ does not hesitate: "Peace of mind," he says.

"Just the peace of mind to know every month that we can show up, we can be there for our kids," he says. "I think that's the most important thing."

That kind of peace matters even more in today's economy. "We used to be naive to how hard the world can really be and how hard it's getting," AJ says.

Shelby agrees. "It's just a different world today," she says. "And people need Melaleuca."

That line lands with real force. The Fords are not just grateful for what Melaleuca has done for their own family. They are more convinced than ever that Melaleuca offers what matters right now for families—better products, more money, and a path toward greater stability.

## Time Is the Greatest Asset

One of the strongest moments in the interview came when AJ shared his thoughts about time. "When we talk about assets, people usually talk about money or houses," he says. "But the greatest asset we have is time. We will never get more of it."

Shelby felt that in a deeply personal way. In one of the most emotional moments of the conversation, she says, "I just know that we're seeing our kids grow up."

## The Power of Consistency

When others see the transformation that Melaleuca has helped the Fords make in their lives, it naturally invites questions.

Consistency is not glamorous. It is not complicated. But it is what builds momentum. "When you slow down," Shelby says, "it's harder to get that momentum back. Staying in consistent action is huge."

Then she added the kind of counsel that feels especially relevant in a world full of distraction and comparison: "Just never give up on yourself," she says. "Keep your head down. Don't compare. Don't look left and right. That's the worst thing you can do. Just stay in your lane and keep going."

## Leadership Is About Relationships

For someone as naturally driven as Shelby, one of the most valuable insights she shared was on the topic of leadership. “I really think it’s just the relationships,” she says.

Too often, people imagine leaders as having all the answers. Shelby sees it differently. “We’re all kind of just learning this together,” she says. “No one’s perfect. But if you keep going, eventually you win.”

As she trains her team, her focus is not on trying to make everyone build exactly like she builds. It is on knowing what people need, showing up, and helping them keep moving. “I am 100% always available to my team,” she says.

## Facing Fears

Another standout moment in the interview was their honesty about the things that scare so many of us.

When Darrin asked what keeps people from embracing the opportunity in front of them, Shelby answered immediately: “Fear.”

“It’s all these different components of fear,” she says. “And the biggest one is fear of *what people are going to think of me.*”

AJ agreed, though he admitted his own fear shows up a little differently. “For me, the *noes* derail me,” he says. “I take them too personally. Don’t let the *noes* stop you.”

He also admitted another challenge he has. “I very much struggle in the area of comparison,” AJ says. “It gives me impostor syndrome.”

That kind of transparency matters. It reminds everyone that even experienced leaders still have to work through fear, rejection, and self-doubt. The difference is that they keep moving anyway.

Shelby’s response to that pressure was simple and strong: “Just lean into your own strengths and be yourself.”

That is good advice for every growing leader. You do not need to become someone else in order to win here. You need to stay in action, stay coachable, and keep building from your own strengths.

## What They Know for Sure

Sixteen years into building, the Fords’ belief in Melaleuca has only deepened. “I just feel like Melaleuca will always be here,” Shelby says. “It feels secure and safe here.”

AJ added his own perspective: “It can be your vehicle to being debt-free, to greater time freedom, to kids, to travel—whatever your *why* is, Melaleuca can be that vehicle.”

That’s a powerful statement, especially because they are speaking from lived experience.

## Their Challenge to Anyone Still Wondering


For the person who is still hesitating, still wondering whether or not now is the time to really go for it, Shelby and AJ concluded their interview with a challenge.

“Take that next step,” Shelby says. “Go all in. Just start doing the activity. Keep it simple. Do your approaches daily. And don’t stop. You’ll start to see those results.”

The challenge AJ issued was just as practical: “Trust your leadership team,” he says. “Listen to them and be coachable.”

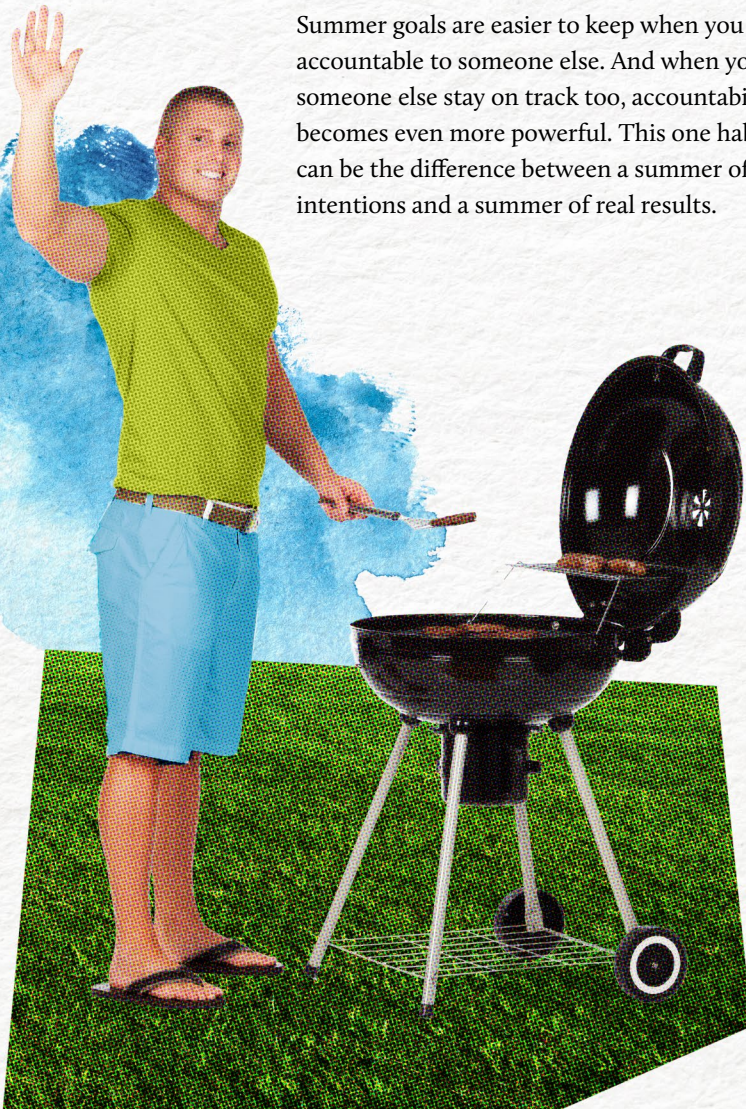

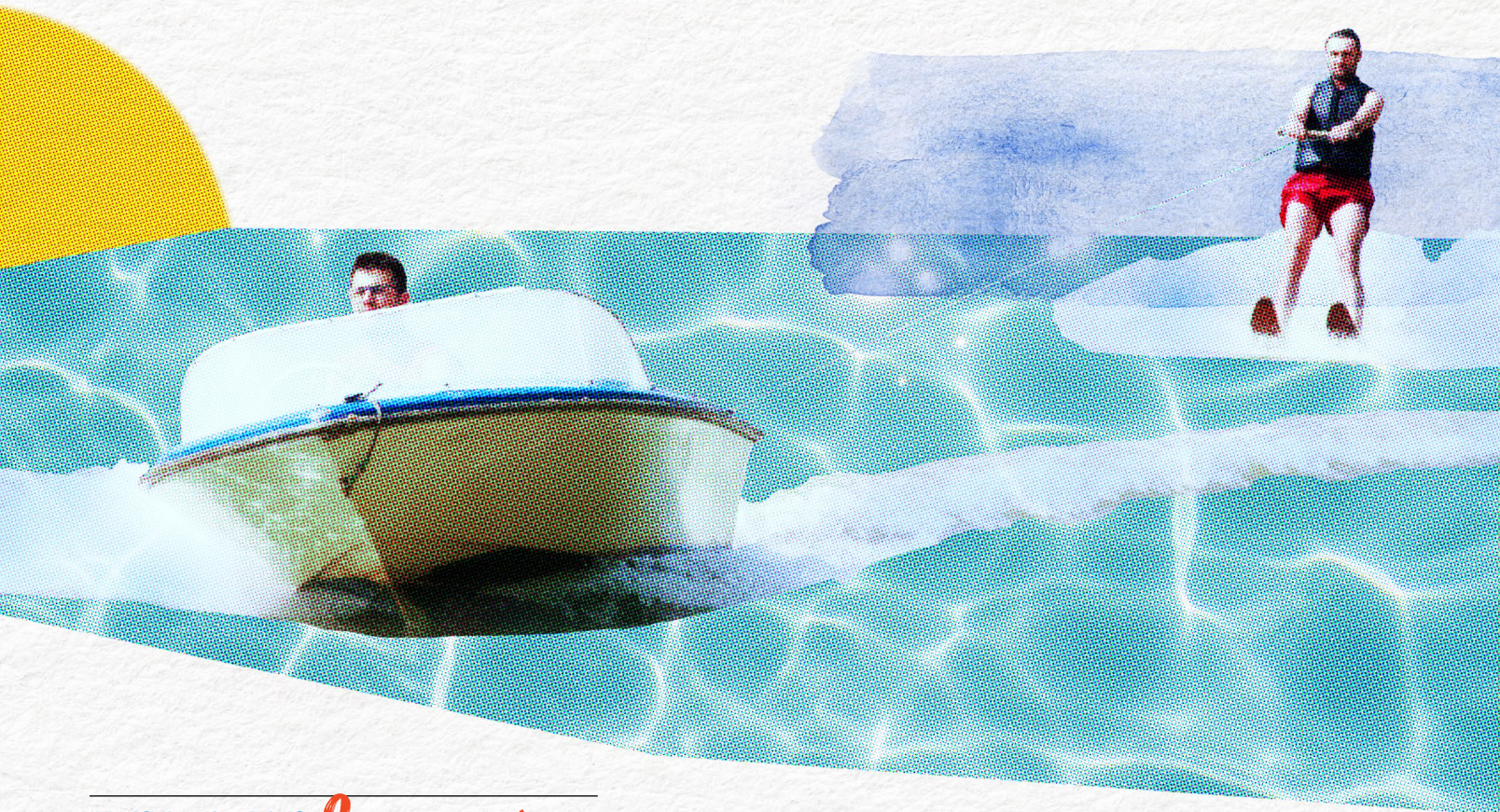

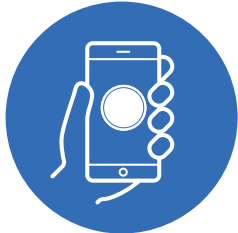

# Outdoors

***Researchers are turning to nature as a powerful tool to alleviate occasional stress while supporting focus and longevity. Discover why stepping outside might be the most powerful wellness habit you're overlooking.***

In 1877, naturalist John Muir wrote, “*In every walk with Nature one receives far more than they seek.*” More than a century later, science is catching up to the instinctive knowledge that we are not separate from nature—we are sustained by it.

And yet, modern life has quietly pulled us away. In 2026, we're more connected to devices than to the natural world around us. Nearly half of Americans rarely spend time outdoors, and 9 in

10 US adults now say they go online every day, according to a recent poll from the Pew Research Center. This includes 41% who report using the internet almost constantly.

While research shows that it's best to fully immerse yourself in nature three days a year, it doesn't take a week-long wilderness retreat to feel the difference that nature can make on your mind, body, and emotional well-being.

You may have heard of forest bathing, a poetic term for walking in the woods that was developed by Japanese researchers who discovered that walking in nature had significant physiological and psychological benefits. Hundreds of studies from around the world continue to support this concept. Scientists suspect that aerosols from the forests, inhaled during a walk, are behind elevated levels of Natural Killer (NK) cells in the immune system, which fight tumors and infections. A subsequent study in which essential oils from cedars were emitted in a hotel room where people slept also caused a significant spike in NK cells.



According to the American Psychological Association, exposure to nature has been linked to a host of benefits, including improved attention, lower stress, better mood, reduced risk of psychiatric disorders, and even upticks in empathy and cooperation.

### A BRAIN THAT BREATHEs AGAIN

You probably know the feeling: You step into a beautiful natural setting, and something subtle but powerful begins to shift in your mental awareness. The constant demand to focus on things like emails, deadlines, news headlines, and notifications starts to ease.

The result is a sense of peace.

Psychologists have a term for this phenomenon: attention restoration. In daily life, we rely on directed attention to stay on task, but it's mentally exhausting. Nature, on the other hand, gently engages our involuntary attention—the effortless awareness sparked by wind through the trees, flowing water, or waves crashing on a beach.

Research shows that time spent in nature improves memory, increases cognitive flexibility, and sharpens concentration. The National Institutes of Health (NIH) found that children who spend just 20 minutes a day in nature show improved concentration and reduced ADHD symptoms.

In a study published in the *Journal of Environmental Psychology*, participants who took a 40-second break to look at greenery performed better on mental tasks than those who stared at a concrete roof for the same amount of time.

### THE CHEMISTRY OF CALM

Time outdoors triggers two measurable changes in the body:

1. Cortisol, the hormone linked to stress, begins to drop—sometimes within just 20 minutes!
2. At the same time, your brain increases its production of serotonin, the neurotransmitter associated with happiness and emotional stability.

Sunlight plays a key role here. Exposure to natural light helps the body produce vitamin D, a nutrient closely tied to mood regulation. Sunlight also helps regulate melatonin to encourage quality sleep.

### NATURE AS MEDICINE FOR THE MIND

For those navigating anxiety, depression, or burnout, nature can offer relief. In one study conducted by researchers from the University of Michigan and published in the *Journal of Affective Disorders*, individuals diagnosed with a major depressive disorder took a 50-minute walk. Half walked through a natural setting, while the others walked in an urban environment. The results were striking: Those who walked in nature experienced significantly greater improvements in mood and reductions in negative thought patterns.

Even more compelling, brain scans have shown that time in nature reduces activity in the area of the brain linked to rumination—the repetitive cycle of negative thinking associated with anxiety and depression. This growing body of research has given rise to ecotherapy, a therapeutic approach centered on healing through nature. From gardening to hiking to simply sitting under trees, these practices are being recognized as legitimate tools for mental health.

A recent meta-analysis from the NIH found evidence suggesting that exposure to natural environments may reduce cortisol levels, which is one of the most frequently studied biological markers of stress.

### MOVEMENT YOU'RE MORE LIKELY TO LOVE

Time outdoors has been linked to improved cardiovascular health, lower cholesterol, and better blood sugar regulation. Exposure to green spaces can reduce inflammation and boost immune function, lowering the risk of certain diseases. Proximity matters too! Living near parks or green spaces has been associated with lower levels of anxiety and improved overall health outcomes.

Most importantly, exercising in nature encourages consistency. When being active feels enjoyable, it becomes sustainable.

A 30-minute walk in a park can improve circulation and reduce risk factors for chronic disease. Even

better, combining movement with nature amplifies emotional benefits, boosting mood and self-esteem more than indoor workouts.

### CONNECTING TO WELLNESS

Outdoor spaces invite shared experiences: community events, walks with friends, family picnics, and even conversations with strangers. These interactions foster a sense of belonging, which can feel increasingly rare in a digitally driven world.

But the connection goes deeper than that. Researchers have found that people who feel connected to nature report greater life satisfaction, stronger relationships, and a deeper sense of purpose.


According to the American Psychological Association, individuals with a strong connection to nature report higher levels of happiness, purpose, and life satisfaction.

### YOU DON'T HAVE TO GO FAR

No time to travel? No problem! Experiencing nature doesn't require a plane ticket or a full day off. Even if you live in a city, you can find ways to benefit from the mental, emotional, and physical effects of the outdoors. It can be as simple as:

- A walk through your nearest park
- Sitting near a window with a view of trees
- Listening to birdsong
- Adding live plants to your workspace
- Stepping outside for a few minutes of sunlight

Research suggests that spending just two hours per week in nature is enough to significantly improve health and well-being—but even shorter moments can make a difference!

You don't have to describe yourself as “outdoorsy” to reap the benefits of nature. Start small by noticing the air, the light, and the sounds in your environment. Because in a world that constantly asks for your attention, nature offers the chance to return to yourself. And as John Muir knew all along—you'll likely receive far more than you ever expected!

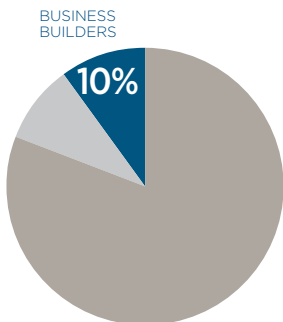

Before Riley Childs ever saw Melaleuca as a business, she saw it through the eyes of a mother.

Her oldest daughter had been struggling through a difficult health season, and Riley was doing what mothers do: searching, asking questions, and trying to find a better path forward. She already knew about Melaleuca from her childhood—her mother had been a Member and used the products—but now she had a reason to look again.
