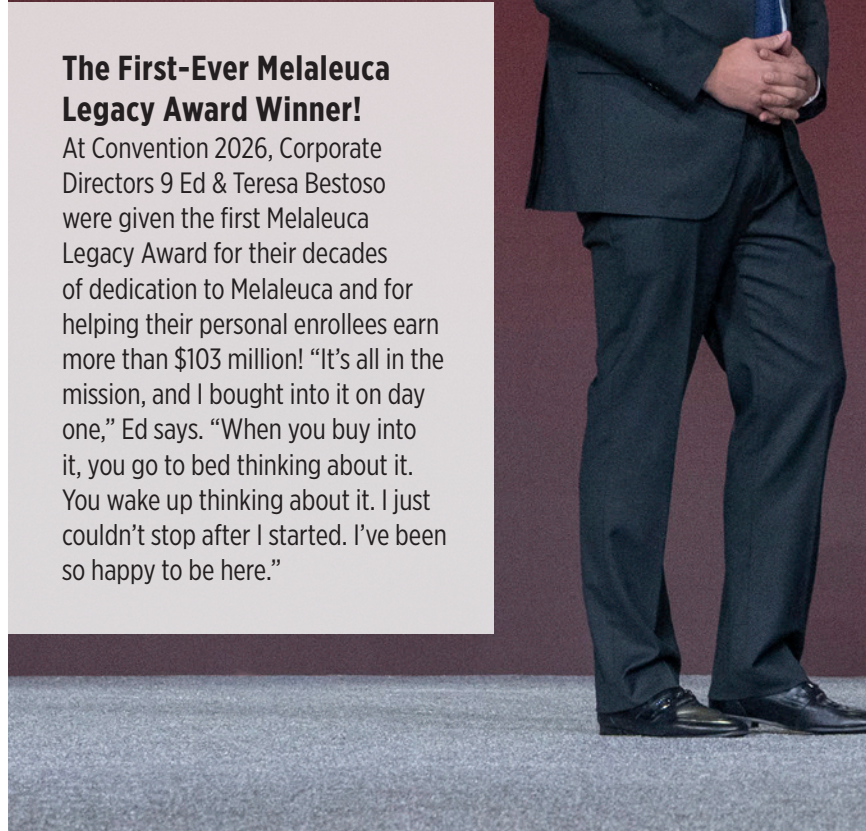

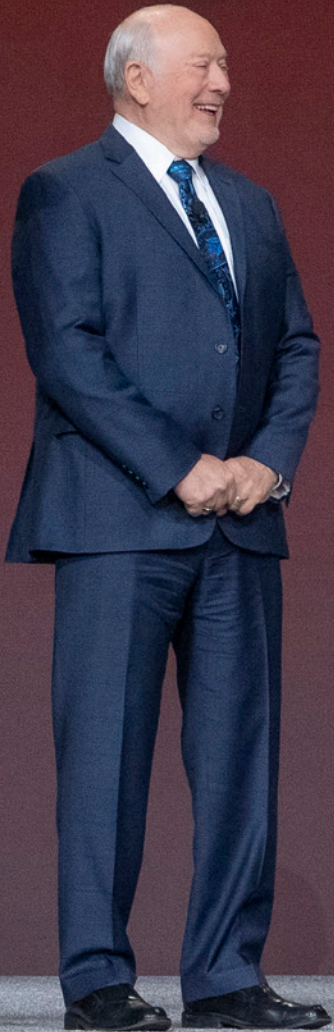


The First-Ever Melaleuca Legacy Award Winner!

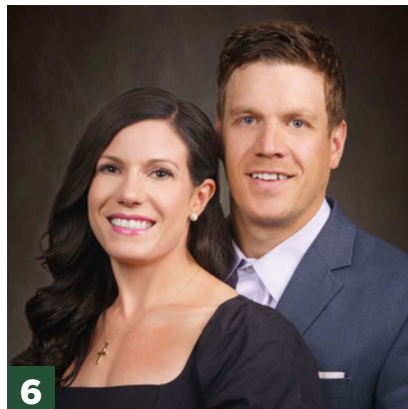

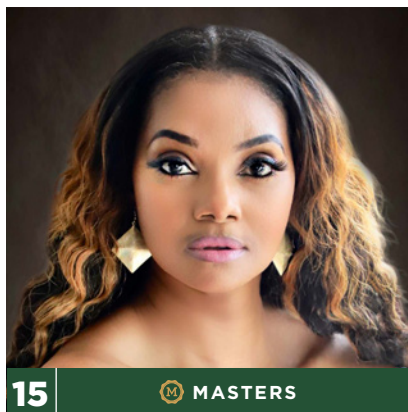

How to Be One Step Bigger

Let me ask you a question that might hit a little harder than you expect: Why aren't you bigger than you are? I don't mean being more famous and having more followers. I mean bigger in your leadership. Bigger in your impact. Bigger in the life you're building for your family.

Because if you're honest with yourself, you'll admit you've felt that there's a bigger version of you inside yourself. You've seen glimpses of that person. You just haven't fully stepped into them yet.

After years of coaching leaders and working with Melaleuca Marketing Executives around the world, I've learned something important: Most people are perfectly able to do the work well, but they are limited by what they've decided is "reasonable." That's the story they tell themselves. And over time, that quiet decision becomes a ceiling—a ceiling on their leadership, income, growth, and eventually their life.

The Dangerous Middle

Comfort is a liar. Yet people drift all the time into a place where they're comfortable but not fulfilled. From the outside, life looks fine. Inside, however, there's restlessness. There's the sense that they're capable of making a bigger contribution and leading a bigger life.

If you feel that tension, it's a signal! One of the reasons Melaleuca is so powerful is because building your Melaleuca business forces you to grow. You can't build leaders while staying small yourself.

The Real Problem

Most people don't need to work harder. They need to think bigger. You will never consistently outperform the size of your own thinking! People get stuck trying to quietly base their future on what they used to earn, what their friends are doing, what feels realistic, and so forth. Without realizing it, they're building an

invisible ceiling for themselves. Instead of asking what's possible, they start to ask, "What's reasonable for someone like me?"

That question will keep your life small.

My Own Story

I grew up in rural Minnesota with a wonderful family and a great upbringing. But my world was small. I didn't come from wealth, but I learned the importance of hard work. I went to school in Fargo, North Dakota, and worked at UPS to pay my way through college. And yes—Fargo is cold.

Sometimes the biggest thing holding you back is the story you've accepted about yourself.

So I invite you to ask yourself this question: What would I pursue if I stopped using my past as the benchmark? Because your future doesn't need your permission. It needs your decision.

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The People Around You Matter

Business philosopher Jim Rohn said, “You are the average of the five people you spend the most time with.” Your environment shapes your standards. I suggest that your five could be the people you spend time with as well as the thoughts and insights you consume from books, podcasts, and conversations—the voices you allow into your life. Why? Because whatever you surround yourself with eventually becomes normal.

One of my favorite quotes is, “If you want to be a lion, train with lions.” That’s one of the reasons Convention matters so much. At Convention 2026, something became crystal clear to me: The leaders who think bigger achieve bigger. Not because they’re better, but because they’re willing to take on bigger challenges. They decide faster, stay more consistent, and stretch more. And their results follow!

Senior Directors 4 Toree and Channing Allen stood on the main stage during Convention 2026 to share their story. Toree told us how she always felt deep in her heart like she was meant for more. Even though she attempted to provide for her family by starting a small business making balloon garlands, and even when the Allens drained their savings to buy the family business, she and Channing were thinking bigger. They run the family business together now and are taking it to new heights.

Then Toree became a Melaleuca Marketing Executive. She didn’t know what she was doing, but she stayed coachable, kept her standards high, and continued to step outside her comfort zone. And as she followed her enroller’s example in pouring belief into her team members, her own belief kept growing as well—and her business began growing by leaps and bounds. The Allens are perfect examples of leaders who think bigger and achieve bigger as a result.

The Dinner Question I Never Forgot

Years ago, I was working in the pharmaceutical industry when one of my mentors, Jerry McCabe, flew into Chicago to have dinner with me. He offered me a bigger role at the corporate headquarters.

I said no.

Then he asked me a question I’ll never forget. He said, “You’ve been in your role four years now. Are you bored?”

I was, and he knew it before I admitted it. I told him, “I’m not ready.”

He smiled and said, “You’ll never be ready.”

That conversation taught me something important. Your feelings are not instructions. They’re just a weather report. Yet too many people stay small because they’re waiting to “feel ready” before they take action.

Choose the Stretch

Astronaut Christina Koch once said, “Do what scares you.” That’s a North Star for all of us. The path of least resistance rarely changes your life—or anyone else’s. If you want new results, you need new discomfort. That’s true physically, mentally, professionally, and spiritually. Growth lives at the edge. And maybe that nervous feeling you have right now is growth, not fear.


A Challenge for You

Before you finish this article, write this down: “**The bigger version of me would...**” Then finish the sentence with one action you can take today. Make the call. Make the approach. Register for Convention 2027. Have the conversation. Then do it—today.

Because before you gain the confidence, you have to take the action.

My Closing Thoughts

One of the things I love most about Melaleuca is that this business refuses to let you stay small. It stretches you, challenges you, and develops you. When you decide to build something meaningful, you begin to grow into the kind of leader capable of building it. And who knows—the real opportunity in front of you right now isn’t just bigger business growth. It’s a bigger version of YOU.

What is the bigger version of you asking you to do right now? Don’t wait until you feel ready. Take the step. Make the call. Choose the stretch. Comfort will always try to talk you out of the life you’re capable of building. And now, more than ever, the world needs leaders who refuse to stay small.

Three Actions That Will Change Your Life

1. Change Your Reference Point

Spend time around bigger thinkers—people who challenge you, stretch you, and make bigger goals feel normal.

2. Make a Decision

A decision is neither a wish nor a “someday”—it is one real commitment that changes your direction.

2026 Marketing Executives of the Year Morgan & Derek Martin

BUILDING THE FOUNDATION FOR MORE

There is a song that has defined Morgan Martin's last few years. It is called "I Made It," by CAIN. "It's a song about making it through all life throws at you," Morgan explains.



As CAIN sings of storms, suffering, and miracles, Morgan recognizes the power of perseverance in her own life. She made it through the early years in an MLM company that nearly cost her everything. She made it through a devastating miscarriage. She made it through a lawsuit, a bankruptcy, a forced move, and the slow rebuilding of her life from the ground up.

And now Morgan has made it, twice, to the stage at Melaleuca Convention as Marketing Executive of the Year!

There are only a handful of Marketing Executives in Melaleuca's history who have ever earned this title back-to-back. Morgan Martin, at 31 years old, is one of them. To earn this title once is the work of a career. To earn it twice is the work of character.

Because to build a business that lasts, Morgan has come to believe that you cannot skip the harder project. You have to keep building the person who can carry it.

Building Belief

Belief is the first ingredient in every approach, enrollment, and advancement. A Marketing Executive can have the products, the scripts, the tools, and the training and still go nowhere if belief is absent. Belief is what turns a wish into a goal. It is what turns a tired morning into a day with momentum.

Morgan understands this with the precision of someone who has had to rebuild her own belief more than once.

Not long after advancing to Corporate Director 3, Morgan found herself staring up at the next goal as if she were standing at the foot of Mount Everest. Corporate Director 4 was possible, but possible did not mean easy. She knew exactly how much work it would take.

Can I do this again? Was that season lightning in a bottle? Can I keep developing leaders? Can I keep helping people rise?

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As her team prepared for Leadership Quest 2026, Morgan asked everyone what they hoped to bring home from the event. They each answered, then turned the question back to her.

“I just want to believe I can reach Corporate Director 4,” Morgan told them.

She found that reminder at Quest in a room full of Directors who were catching the vision of Melaleuca and leaving with the words “I’m going Senior” on their lips. Morgan saw their hunger, their willingness, and their excitement. It reminded her that there are still so many people out there

who are searching for everything that Melaleuca has to offer them, and she could help them reach their goals.

Her belief surged back. The next climb still looked steep, but it no longer looked impossible.

As a leader, Morgan does more than maintain her own belief. She builds it in others one finish line at a time.

Director 3 Sam Adams is one example. Sam was a longtime customer and friend Morgan had met at a CrossFit gym in Michigan. Sam loved the products, but she did not see herself as a business builder. In August 2025, Morgan reached out and invited her to earn that month’s promotion. She did not ask Sam to build an organization. She simply told her that if she shared the products she already loved with a few friends, she could earn the promotional gift.

The first goal felt reachable. So Sam tried.

As Sam began sharing Melaleuca with her friends and family, they were more interested in Melaleuca products than Sam had first expected.

“You’re already this close,” Morgan told her. “Let’s just go for Director.”

Sam said *yes*. Then Morgan encouraged her toward Director 2. Then she encouraged her to participate in PartnerUp Quest. Sam earned the PartnerUp Cruise, advanced to Director 3, and has continued building a business she once did not think she could build.

“To build belief, you meet people where they are,” Morgan says. “For Sam, it was the warming mats. Then the next thing. Then the next thing.”

That is one of Morgan’s gifts as a leader. She does not hand people belief from a distance. She builds it beside them, one small win at a time.

Building Discipline

If belief is a spark, discipline is the fuel that makes it roar into a flame.

Every Marketing Executive who has looked at Morgan’s results has probably wondered at some point

what she is doing when no one is watching. Derek knows the answer.

“She masters the mundane,” he says. “She does consistently what others are only willing to do occasionally. She doesn’t make excuses. She just does what needs to be done.”

Morgan’s discipline was shaped early. When she wanted to quit piano lessons as a child, her parents

told her she could quit after she learned one full song. When she wanted to leave a sport midseason, they reminded her that other people were counting on her.

Those lessons stayed with her. You do not quit just because something feels hard. You do not disappear when people are depending on you.

“I hate the word ‘motivation,’” Morgan says. Motivation, she will tell you, is a feeling, and feelings are unreliable. Discipline is different.

Discipline is working from what you want most, not what you feel in the moment.

“I show up when it’s hard. I show up when I don’t feel like it,” Morgan says.

“The people at the top—the ones who are where you want to be—have heard no more than you have. If

you’re willing to hear it enough, you can reach any goal you want in Melaleuca.”

Every morning, Morgan is up before her children are awake, doing the work she calls “playing offense”—making approaches, following up, and preparing social media posts.

“I always tell my team to play offense in the morning and defense for the rest of the day,” Morgan says.

“You can stay in the game playing good defense, but you’re not going to score any points.”

She plans her approach list ahead of time so she is not spending valuable work time deciding who to contact. She schedules social media content so a busy day does not derail her. She does chores around the house while she’s on the phone and doing Strategy Sessions. Each pocket of her day is used with purpose so she can be present when her family needs her.

But this year, discipline has taken on another meaning.

Morgan has learned the discipline of rest.

It sounds counterintuitive for someone in one of the fastest growth seasons of her career, but Morgan has discovered that putting her phone down, stepping away, and being fully present with her family has made her better, not weaker.

“I come back to my business more full,” she says. “Not from a place of exhaustion and frustration, but from a place of having more to give.”

Derek has seen the change in real time. “She is operating from a place of peace this year rather than a place of necessity,” he says. “And that has made this business a lot more enjoyable for both of us.”

Building Leaders

When Derek told their four-year-old son, Brooks, that Mommy had earned Marketing Executive of the Year again, he explained it the simplest way he could: “Mommy won!”

Brooks thought about that for a moment, then asked the question only a child would ask: “Does that mean everybody else loses?”

Morgan laughs every time she tells the story. “I said, ‘Actually, no. That’s the best part. I won,

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but nobody else had to lose for me to win.' That's our culture. Your success doesn't take away from mine."

This is not a philosophy Morgan invented. It is the foundation of Melaleuca's business model. There is no shortcut, no workaround, no version of Marketing Executive of the Year that does not stem from the success of the members on your team. The leaders who rise highest at Melaleuca are the ones who have made building others their primary work.

Morgan leads with what she calls humility. She asks questions. She asks for ideas. She asks what is working for them. "I never want it to feel like 'I'm going to teach you,'" she says. "I want to learn from my team too. It creates a culture where everyone feels like their voice matters."

That does not mean Morgan avoids hard conversations. In fact, she believes hard conversations can be one of the most loving things a leader does.

"In leadership, you can't treat people how you want to be treated," Morgan says. "You have to treat them how they want to be treated."

Some team members want direct feedback. Others need more gentleness. Some need to be challenged. Others need belief poured into them first. Morgan studies the people she leads so she can help them in the language they understand.

Senior Director 2 Casey Russell experienced that kind of leadership firsthand. Casey had been successful in another company but had burned out. After Morgan approached her, Casey initially declined. Morgan kept loving her, kept inviting her, and kept showing her what was different about Melaleuca.

Eventually, Casey enrolled. She shopped. She got excited. Then, for a stretch, not much happened.

In one conversation, Casey admitted she felt frustrated. At her MLM, she could carry people across the finish line. At Melaleuca, she could not do the business for them.

"In leadership, you can't treat people how you want to be treated. You have to treat them how they want to be treated."

“Then why aren’t you still there?” Morgan asked.

“Because I got burned out,” Casey said.

“Okay,” Morgan told her. “Then try something different.”

Casey did. She learned to lead in a new way. Today, she is a Senior Director 2.

Morgan uses that same bridge with new builders throughout her organization. She will do the first Strategy Session *for* them. She will do the second *with* them. She will *listen* as they do the third. Then, by the fourth, she expects them to *lead*.

“You’ve got this,” she tells them.

That is how Morgan builds leaders. She gives them support, then space. Guidance, then ownership.

Her next business goal is not centered on her own advancement. “I have Executive Directors and Senior Directors on my team who want to develop new Senior Directors to have in those seats at Convention next year,” Morgan says. “Filling those seats with my team is my next goal.”

Building a Great Life

Ask Morgan what it means to live a great life, and she does not start with the stage, the status, or the check.

“For me, it’s living a life I can’t wait to get back home to,” she says.

Melaleuca has taken Morgan to beautiful places. She has earned recognition, travel, income, and had experiences she once only dreamed about. But the true measure of her life is not whether she gets to leave home for something extraordinary—it’s whether she loves the life waiting for her when she returns.

That life has required its own kind of building.

Over the past year, Morgan has been learning to live from peace rather than pressure. Through faith, counseling, and deep inner work, she has rebuilt her sense of worth, learning to separate who she is from what she achieves.

For much of her life, Morgan believed that only her success determined her value. If she achieved, she felt worthy. If she missed the goal, she questioned

herself. That belief fueled her for a long time, but it also exhausted her.

Now she sees it differently.

“Before, achievement was who I was,” Morgan says. “Now achievement is something I do.”

Morgan can still dream. She can still build. She can still pursue Corporate Director 5, 6, 7, and beyond.

But she does not need a status to tell her who she is. She now works from a place of peace and confidence, no longer driven by pressure and anxiety.


Derek sees the difference at home.

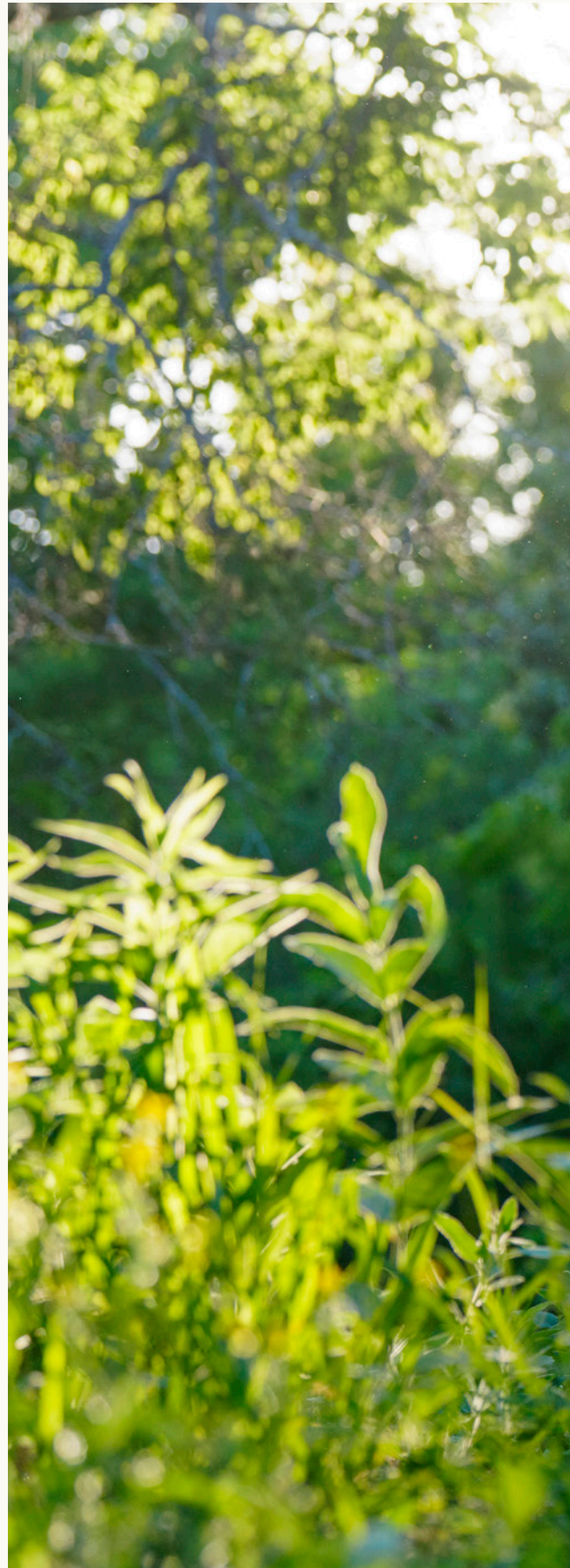
He hears her talk more about what an advancement will do for someone else than what it will do for her. He watches her choose family time instead of rushing to finish one more task. He has seen her build a healthier balance while still growing one of the strongest businesses in Melaleuca.

Their children may not understand what Marketing Executive of the Year means yet. But Morgan hopes they remember something more lasting.

She hopes Brooks and Taya remember a mother who was present. A mother who loved them, set expectations for them, and met them with grace and patience. A mother whose face, when they picture it years from now, is smiling and laughing.

The home the Martins are building will be finished soon. Brooks and Taya will run through rooms that do not yet have furniture, learning the shape of the place where they will grow up. Derek and Morgan will stand somewhere in the middle of it and likely feel, for a moment, the weight of everything it took to get there.

Morgan Martin has made it. Not to the top, but through one challenge after another. And what she has built along the way—belief, discipline, leaders, peace, and character—is what will carry her into whatever comes next.

It's Never Too Late to Begin Again



Ten and a half years is a long time to wait for the next advancement. For many people, it might have been long enough to give up. Instead, Valerie chose to begin again.

6 PRINCIPLES FOR BUILDING A LASTING LEGACY

These leadership insights shaped Convention 2026. Now it's your turn to put them into action!

Momentum doesn't happen by accident. Legacy isn't built overnight. Strong relationships require intention. And meaningful service requires us to think beyond ourselves. Yet when all of those things come together, something extraordinary happens—lives transform for the better!

We heard from so many Melaleuca leaders at Convention 2026, but I wanted to highlight a few major themes from those trainings and presentations. I hope they inspire you to look back at this event and say, "This was the experience that changed everything for me."

THEME 1

Let Momentum Carry You Through

Executive Chairman Frank VanderSloot spent a lot of time talking about momentum and urgency, and his message couldn't have come at a better time. We just experienced a record-breaking Fast

Track period, and every one of you should be proud of what you've accomplished.

However, momentum is fragile. It takes effort to build and discipline to maintain. Advancements, enrollments, customer growth, and developing leaders all create momentum—and once it's gone, it's much harder to get back. Frank reminded us that it's easier to keep momentum than it is to rebuild it.

One of my favorite examples was his marathon analogy. If you're running a race, you can slow down and catch your breath, but you can't sit down. The moment you let fatigue take over, getting started again becomes much more difficult. The same principle applies to building a business. Consistent action—even at a slower pace—keeps you moving forward.

Corporate Director 7 Alan Pariser reinforced that message during the workshops. He reminded us that people need what we offer now more than ever before. People are looking for solutions, stability, and a way to create a better future.

The need is real. The opportunity is real. And the time to act is NOW!

THEME 2

Your Legacy Is What You Create

The second major theme we heard throughout the week was leadership,

responsibility, and the impact we leave behind. How many of you listened to the speakers onstage and thought, “I want to be there someday?” Or watched the legacy leaders—people who have represented this company for 20, 25, 30, 35, and 40 years—walk across the stage and imagined what it would feel like to leave that kind of impact? Think about Corporate Director 9 Ed Bestoso and his beautiful wife. Together, they have earned \$66 million and have helped their personal enrollees earn over \$100 million! That is a legacy for their babies and your babies and my babies. My point is that these leaders have built an incredibly strong foundation through years of consistent effort, service, and commitment. And you can too.

THEME 3

Relationships, Community, Family

In this business, there are ups and downs, victories and setbacks, and moments that test us. But it's the relationships that stay steady through it all.

Executive Director 6 Meghan Dirk shared a message that really resonated with me. She talked about the importance of surrounding yourself with the right people. Looking around this room, I couldn't agree more! Many of us have found more than a business here—we've found a community and built friendships that extend far beyond products, presentations, and events. We've celebrated life's greatest moments together, and we've stood by each other through some of life's hardest challenges.

A few members of my own team have recently been hit with things that you pray you never, ever have to go through—especially as a parent. But

watching them support each other has just been so incredible. We really do create friendships that are different than anything else outside of what we have going on here. I think it's because we're building something that's bigger than ourselves.

Business philosopher Jim Rohn once said, “You are the average of the five people you spend the most time with.” Whether or not that's literally true, the principle is powerful. The people you surround yourself with influence your mindset, your habits, your goals, and, ultimately, your future. So choose your circle wisely. Because when amazing people come together with a shared purpose, amazing things happen!

THEME 4

Live the Mission

The fifth lesson we heard throughout the week was about service and mission. What's Melaleuca's mission? Hopefully you know it by heart. But more importantly, I hope it's written on your heart.

Corporate Director 9 Ed Bestoso often says that the force of who you are will naturally be reflected in what you do. Executive Director 9 Chantel Brooks reminded us that building a business starts with changing your own life first.

Both of them are spot on.

There is no shame in fighting for your family. There is no shame in wanting something better for your future. If you're out there working hard, paying off debt, creating opportunities, and building a better life for the people you love, that's something to be proud of.

But living the mission goes deeper than personal success. Getting burned out is much harder when you embrace service as your purpose. Why? Because your focus shifts from yourself to the people you're

helping. Every customer served, every family impacted, and every life changed becomes part of something larger than your own goals.

President Cole Clinger was absolutely right when he said, “We don't stop until every one of our people have reached their goals.”

THEME 5

Be a Steward of the Products

One message we heard repeatedly at Convention was simple: products first. National Director 9 Brooke Paulin, National Director 9 Chelsie Gilbert, Corporate Director 9 Ed Bestoso, and Frank VanderSloot all echoed the same principle. Melaleuca is a wellness product company.

Think about it. We don't spend our days creating content about a pipe dream or beach vacation money. We talk about products because the products are what create lasting customers. That's why we have a 97% monthly retention rate!

Sometimes we can get so focused on enrollments, ranks, and growth that we forget what brought us here in the first place. How many of you joined because of *Tub & Tile™*? *Sol-U-Mel®*? *The Peak Performance Pack®*? *Mela-Out® Magnesium*? Anyway, now you're here!

I also love that we get to give people the opportunity to eat high-quality, hormone-free, antibiotic-free *Riverbend Ranch® Black Label Beef*. And by supporting small ranches, we champion the little guy even in that space!

My point is that you should never overlook the power of what we have. There are millions of people who are still using products that don't deliver the results they're looking for—these are the potential customers who are waiting to hear about solutions that could genuinely improve their lives.

THEME 6


Lead with Faith

The final theme woven throughout Convention was faith. Think about it: Was there a single story shared that didn't include faith in some way? Not necessarily faith in a religious sense, but faith in something bigger than ourselves. Faith in Melaleuca. Faith in our leadership team. Faith in our products. Faith in the people we serve. And perhaps most importantly, faith in each other!

Frank VanderSloot said that faith is the most powerful force on the planet. If we believe we can do something, we're far more likely to achieve it. But he also reminded us that true faith isn't blind optimism—it's built on evidence and experience. When Melaleuca began, there wasn't much evidence to point to. There were no decades

of success stories, no \$2 billion in annual sales, no clinical trials, and no proven track record. Yet Frank and the early leaders moved forward anyway because they believed in the vision long before the results were visible.

Today, we have more than four decades of growth and success along with hundreds of thousands of loyal customers! We have industry-leading retention. We have scientific validation, product innovation, and a proven business model. We have countless stories of lives that were changed because someone chose to believe.

So if you're building a business in 2026, don't let doubt become your biggest obstacle. Believe in the products. Believe in the mission. Believe in the people around you. And most importantly, believe in what is possible for your own future!

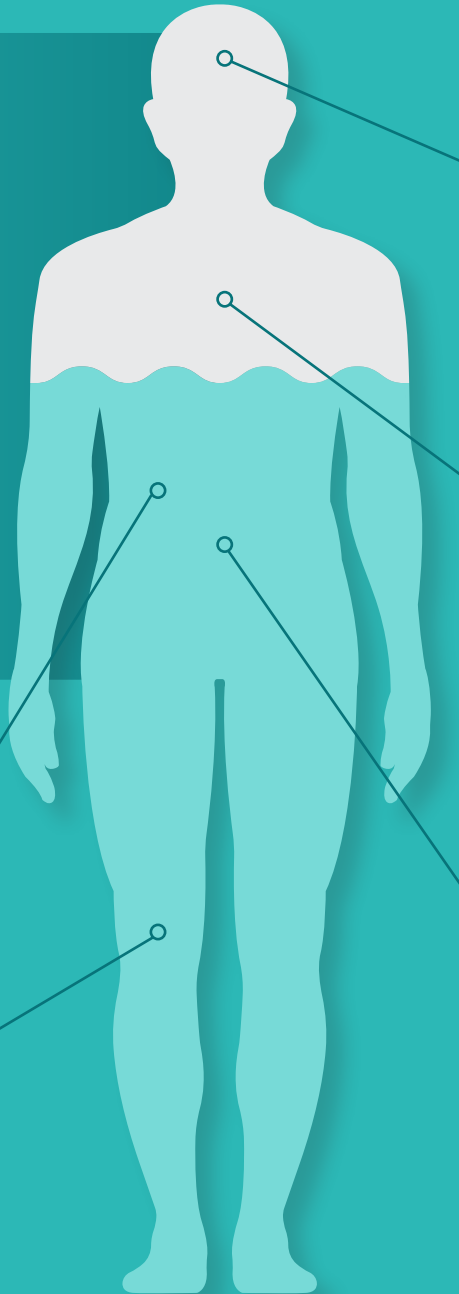

Proper hydration is critical to your total-body wellness!

You depend on water every moment of every day. Every cell in your body needs water to function properly. Staying properly hydrated no matter what you're doing or what your environment is like is essential to enjoying optimal wellness.



BRAIN

Your brain consists of about 73% water and reacts negatively to even mild dehydration. In your brain, dehydration can reduce focus, memory, and mental clarity and increase fatigue, anxiety, and irritability.

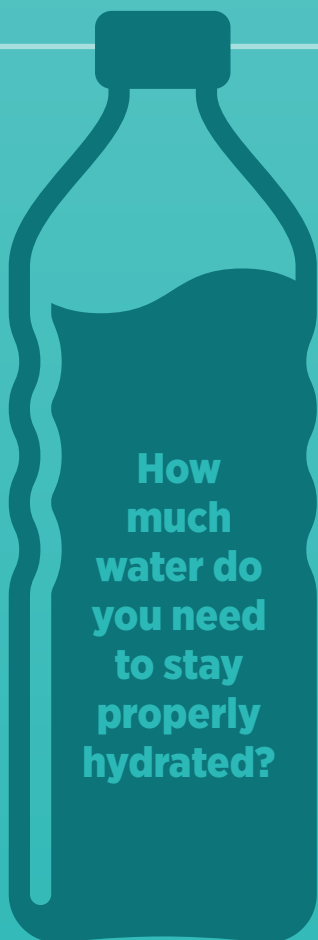
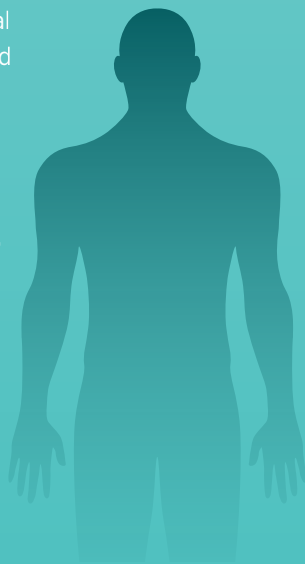

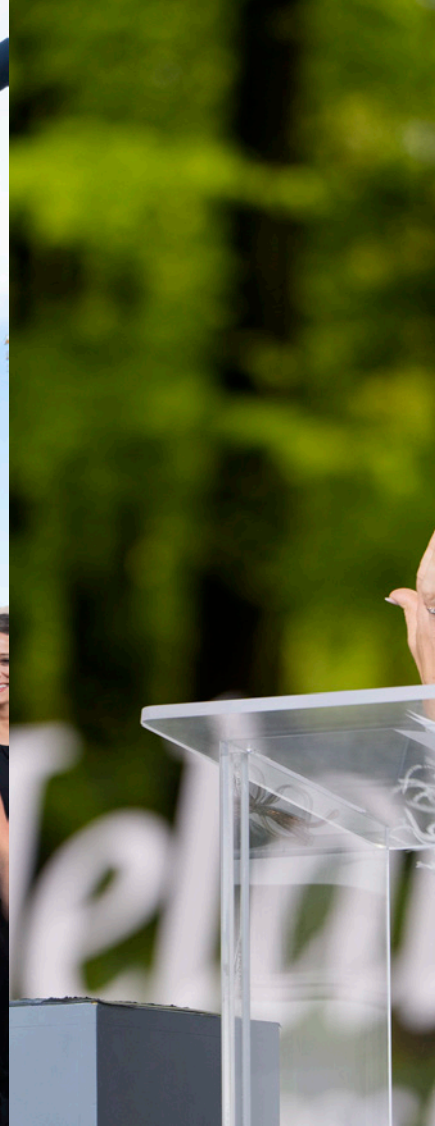

Product Advocates

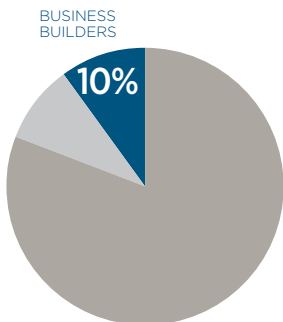
8% of all Melaleuca customers have referred at least one customer but fewer than eight customers. As those customers purchase products directly from Melaleuca, those who referred them receive a small commission. These households are not necessarily interested in the financial opportunity. Their relationship with Melaleuca is focused on their love of Melaleuca products. Their “status” is determined by how many customers they have referred. A Product Advocate has at least one customer. A Product Advocate 2 has referred at least two customers, and a Product Advocate 3 has referred at least four customers. While these individuals may not be considered serious business builders, their customers (like the vast majority of Melaleuca customers) come from word-of-mouth referrals. Therefore, the overall contribution of these individuals is significant.

Beginning a Business

Advanced Leadership Status

Those Marketing Executives who reach Senior Director or above have shown substantial interest and dedication in building a Melaleuca business. Melaleuca strongly advocates that Marketing Executives do not quit their full-time jobs until their Melaleuca incomes far surpass the incomes they receive from their full-time employers. Rather, they should add their Melaleuca incomes to their regular incomes, thereby making a substantial difference in their family finances.

Your sense of thirst is more complicated—and less reliable—than most people realize. Here's what's actually going on beneath the surface.

You've just finished a long walk on a warm afternoon. You head to the kitchen, pour a tall glass of water, and take a long drink. Within seconds, the dryness in your mouth eases. Your throat relaxes. You feel satisfied.

But that water hasn't actually reached your bloodstream yet. And it won't for at least another half hour. So why did your brain stop telling you to drink?

The answer reveals something surprising about how your body manages one of its most essential resources—and why so many people walk around mildly dehydrated without ever feeling it.

HOW YOUR BRAIN MANAGES THIRST

Deep inside your brain, two small regions keep close watch on the balance of water and salt in your blood. When that ratio shifts even a little, those regions trigger the uncomfortable sensation we call thirst.

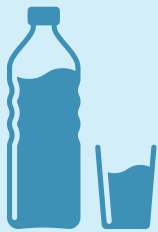
How little of a shift does it take? According to recent reporting in *Quanta Magazine* on the neuroscience of thirst, a change of just 1% in your blood's water content is enough to trip the alarm.

Every chemical reaction in your body runs on a precise water-to-salt ratio. Drift too far in either direction and cells swell or shrink. Brain cells, in particular, lose the ability to signal properly. It's no wonder that your body takes thirst seriously.

There are two different kinds of thirst driven by different brain cells, for different reasons.

Osmotic thirst kicks in when your blood's salt level rises—often after eating something high in sodium, like pizza, bacon, or potato chips. Your brain sends you looking for pure water to dilute that extra salt.

Five Hydration Myths

MYTH: IF YOU'RE NOT THIRSTY, YOU'RE NOT DEHYDRATED.

Thirst is a lagging indicator. By the time the sensation arrives, you're already running a deficit. A 2025 study found that participants showed measurably darker urine and elevated cortisol levels compared to well-hydrated peers, without feeling any more thirsty. Waiting for thirst is a losing strategy.

MYTH: ONLY PURE WATER COUNTS TOWARD HYDRATION.

Your body doesn't check credentials. Coffee, tea, milk, juice, sparkling water, broth, and water-rich foods like cucumbers, watermelon, and strawberries all contribute meaningfully to daily hydration. You can get up to 20% of your fluid needs from food alone. The goal is total fluid intake—not just what's in your water bottle.

MYTH: YELLOW URINE MEANS YOU'RE DEHYDRATED.

Urine color is a useful hydration check, though diet and supplements can affect it too. Riboflavin (vitamin B2) turns urine bright yellow regardless of hydration status. If you supplement regularly, don't rely on color alone. Watch for amber urine, but also headaches, fatigue, or trouble concentrating.

MYTH: YOU CAN'T DRINK TOO MUCH WATER.

Overhydration is rare but real. When the body takes in more water than the kidneys can process, sodium levels drop dangerously low. Sip steadily throughout the day rather than drinking large amounts all at once.

MYTH: YOU NEED EIGHT 8 FL OZ GLASSES OF WATER A DAY.

It's a memorable number, but it has no firm scientific basis. Fluid needs vary based on body size, activity level, climate, diet, and health conditions. See the formula on pages 38–39 to figure out what's right for you.

Hypovolemic thirst happens when your blood volume drops, usually from heavy sweating or illness. In this case, your brain needs both water and minerals because you lost electrolytes along with fluid.

That's why a glass of plain water sometimes hits the spot perfectly and other times it isn't quite enough.

So why does that first sip make your thirst disappear before the water even reaches your bloodstream? Because your brain can't wait that long. It makes a quick guess based on signals from your throat and mouth—cool temperature, moisture, the act of swallowing—and within about a minute, your brain shuts off the thirst response. It's fast and efficient.

But it's just a guess—which means it can be wrong.

RUNNING A DEFICIT

Most people assume that their body will speak up when it needs water. A 2025 study in the *Journal of Applied Physiology* found that that's not always how it works. Researchers tracked hydration levels in participants alongside how thirsty they actually felt—and the two didn't match. Those who were measurably underhydrated reported feeling no thirstier than their well-hydrated peers. That's because mild dehydration can fly under the radar.

When mild dehydration deficits accumulate, the body starts showing the strain in other ways. Energy drops. Thinking slows. Headaches arrive without explanation. Your skin looks duller. Your mood flattens out. Many people reach for coffee or food or chalk it up to a bad night's sleep when what they actually need is a tall glass of water.

So why is it so easy to become dehydrated? Several habits and circumstances drain away our hydration levels without triggering any alarm:

- **Diet patterns.** Fruits and vegetables are a significant source of hydration, yet the CDC reports that only about one in ten American adults eats the recommended daily amount. Carbohydrates also retain water, so people on low-carb diets may be holding onto less fluid than they realize.



- **What we drink.** Alcohol suppresses the hormone that tells your kidneys to conserve water, so you lose more fluid than you take in.
- **Chronic stress.** The hormonal cascade triggered by ongoing stress gradually drains fluid levels.
- **Daily losses.** Through breathing, sweating, urinating, and digesting, you lose six to eight cups of water every day. Add heat or exercise, and that number climbs fast.
- **Medications.** Many common prescriptions increase how much fluid the body loses.

THE STRESS YOU DON'T SEE COMING

Cortisol is the body's primary stress hormone. In moments of pressure, it sharpens your focus, boosts your energy, and prepares your body to respond. When cortisol stays chronically elevated over time, it becomes a problem. Persistently elevated cortisol levels are linked to poor sleep, weakened immunity, weight gain, and a higher risk of chronic disease.

A 2025 study published in the *Journal of Applied Physiology* found that underhydrated participants had cortisol levels more than 50% higher during stressful tasks than their well-hydrated peers. And the participants didn't report feeling particularly worse.

Here's how it works. When your brain detects dehydration, it releases a hormone called vasopressin. Vasopressin signals your kidneys to hold onto water and maintain blood volume—keeping your heart and organs functioning even when fluid is running low. That's its protective role. But vasopressin also reacts to the brain's stress response, increasing the release of cortisol when pressure arrives.

The result is a body that's already working in a kind of low-grade emergency mode. A deadline, a difficult conversation, or a long commute—situations that a well-hydrated person handles with a small release of cortisol—hits harder when the body is short on water.

- The bottom line is striking. Mild dehydration doesn't just slow you down physically—it dials up your biological response to stress before you even notice you're thirsty.

HYDRATION AS YOU AGE

In a study cited by UCLA Health, healthy older adults who went 24 hours without water reported feeling far less thirsty than younger adults who did the same thing. Their bodies needed water just as urgently, but the signal simply didn't fire with the same strength. Separately, UCLA Health reports that up to 40% of adults over 65 experience chronic dehydration—and the consequences can be serious: fatigue, confusion, falls, and even life-threatening infections.

Several factors explain why. The thirst signal becomes less reliable, and the kidneys become less efficient—producing more urine and losing more fluid. Muscle mass matters too: muscles store water, so less muscle means a smaller reserve when intake runs low. Medications compound the problem, particularly diuretics and diabetes drugs, both of which are common in older adults and hard on fluid levels. Chronic conditions like heart disease and diabetes add further disruption.

The most important habit shift is also the simplest one. Drink on a schedule rather than waiting for thirst to arrive. Keep water nearby, sip with every meal, and build hydration into daily routines—a glass after each trip to the restroom, a glass first thing in the morning.

SMALL HABIT, LONG PAYOFF

If good health is built from daily choices, hydration may be the most underrated one. The science keeps turning up new reasons why those small, steady sips matter—steadying your stress response, sharpening your thinking, supporting your kidneys and heart, and slowing the kind of wear and tear that accumulates over decades.

You don't need to overhaul your routine. You just need a little consistency—and the willingness to stop waiting for your body to ask. Because now you know it won't always ask. 🍋
